Dear Fulbright parents and guardians,

The LRSD was granted, from the Arkansas Department of Education, the equivalent of five student attendance days to be used as alternative methods of instruction (AMI) days. AMI days are to be used on days when the LRSD is closed due to extenuating or emergency circumstances such as: inclement weather (snow day), emergency circumstances, or other acts deemed for cancellation.

For the month of January, we will use work packets sent home with each student. The district also has an online platform available for our use. When the platform is accessible to all, teachers will also upload assignments there. When the platform becomes available, we will send home usernames and passwords for you to access.

Included in your packet this month will be:

- Lesson assignments for 5 days
- Tools needed to complete assignments
- A note from your teacher
- A green form to be returned **tomorrow**

In order to count your child as present, they will need to complete the number of days in the packet we missed and return them to their teacher. For example, if we miss 1 day of school, they will need to complete and return 1 day of assignments in the packet.
